**1 MILLION CAMPAIGN GOAL ACHIEVED**

**\$1,087,024.00**

The recent donation of **\$197,823.56** is the net proceeds from a stock transfer made by the donors who wished to remain anonymous. We have now have completed and exceeded our campaign goal of \$1Million. We do request, however, that those who pledged for the campaign to honor their commitment to the Parish. Majority of the donations were cash donation and a few were pledges. We are counting those pledges as part of the total amount of the campaign goal that we have achieved. Again, I am so grateful to all our donors, friends and parishioners of Assumption Parish for all your support, generosity, and kindness to our Parish. Thank you for sharing with us your time, talent, and financial support to address the various needs of our parish and our mission Church. May the Lord repay you a hundredfold for all the good things you are doing and have done for the good of our Parish.

**THANK YOU FOR BEING A BLESSING TO ASSUMPTION PARISH**

Indeed Assumption Parish have received a lot of blessings this year. Thanks to all of you, we are now debt free. We have completed the improvements needed in our Mission Church in Kings Beach, and have set aside about **\$682,327.17** in our Diocesan Account for Future Church Development. We are working now on the preparations for our **150<sup>th</sup> Parish Anniversary this coming August 15, 2019**. Please mark it on your calendar. Various activities are planned for the big event, which includes the 15feet Bronze Statue of Our Lady of Assumption to mark our 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. The statue was sponsored by 4 families and the members of the Finance and Pastoral Councils which signed their consent for this project. These are the legacies we will leave behind for our children and our children's children. **Muchas gracias!!! Maraming salamat po!!! Thank you very much!!!**

**FLU SEASON AND THE PRECAUTIONS**

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has reported that the incidence of flu and flu-like illnesses is widespread and has reached a level requiring that we enact preventive measures Bishop Soto has issued the following directives:

- \* The use of the Communion cup is suspended temporarily.
- \* Receive the Body of Christ in the hand (although receiving on the tongue is permitted).
- \* Do not shake hands. Offer the sign of Peace to those around you with a simple nod, saying "peace be with you."
- \* Do not hold hands during the Our Father.

Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion are reminded to cleanse their hands with an alcohol-based antiseptic before and after administering Holy Communion. This also applies to those who take Holy Communion to the home-bound. The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and other Holy Days does not apply to those who are sick. If you are sick, stay home and take of yourself. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this time. And pray for those who are sick. The administration of Holy Communion in both kinds will resume as soon as the Bishop deems it safe and prudent to do so.

**DEADLINE: CCD STUDENTS PRAYER TESTING**

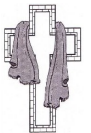

**BAPTISMAL PREPARATION CLASS FOR PARENTS AND SPONSORS**

The next baptismal class will be **Monday, February 18**, at 6pm bilingual, in Truckee. Parents and sponsors, whether the baptism will take place here in Church or elsewhere, **MUST** complete the forms and provide the required documents before sponsors are allowed to take the baptismal class. Sponsors: If single, we will need a sponsor application and a confirmation certificate. If married, we will need a sponsor application, a church marriage certificate and a confirmation certificate for each sponsor. **Parents who are not Married MUST set a meeting with Fr. Vincent prior to being approved.** Sponsors must meet all canonical requirements in order to be approved. Baptismal class certificates will **ONLY** be issued to all approved parents and sponsors. A \$10 donation for the class and certificate will be asked from parents and godparents who will not be baptize at the parish. Please sign-up at the parish office at least a week prior to the class.
