ARE YOU IN AN IRREGULAR MARRIAGE SITUATION?

If you are in an irregular marriage situation such as cohabitation, civil marriage, or divorced and remarried without Church annulment, we invite you to seek canonical advice from Fr. Vince as soon as possible to determine what can be done to rectify your marriage situation. As a canon lawyer, Fr. Vince served fulltime for three years as a judge, at the Marriage Tribunal in the Diocese of Sacramento, rendering decisions for annulment cases prior to his assignment here at Assumption Parish. A donation of \$25.00 to the Church will be asked for the canonical assistance.
