**SECOND YEAR FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION PRAYER TESTING**

We are encouraging all our second year CCD students, both in Truckee and Kings Beach to take their test early. Here are the dates available for testing in Truckee, February 19, March 5, and March 12, between 9am to 11am. In Kings Beach, it will be on February 20, at 6:30pm after the Spanish Mass.

It is much easier to track your donations when you use our Parish envelopes. We have several sets of Sunday donation envelopes available at the Parish office at no cost. You may pick them up in the afternoon during office hours.

**CCD PARENTS' HOMEWORK**

There will be a total of four (4) homework that parents must submit and pass before the end of the school year. The third set of homework is available this weekend at the vestibule by the Mass attendance registration table. Get one (1) for first communion if you have a student for first communion and get one (1) for confirmation if you have students for confirmation.

**WE CONTINUE TO OBSERVE COMMUNION BY THE HAND**

There are two valid ways to receive Holy Communion in the Catholic Church, by the tongue or by the hand. Normally, people may choose the manner they will receive communion. However, due to the ongoing threat of Covid-19 and its new variant, and for the safety and protection of all Mass goers, we ask that people receive communion by the hand. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

**JANUARY 22, SATURDAY – WALK FOR LIFE WEST COAST**

At the parents' orientation and at the beginning of the school year, we reminded all parents to submit the sponsor form for the Sacraments on time. For First Communion it is optional to have a sponsor, but if a parent elected to get one, the sponsor must be eligible based on canonical requirements. For Confirmation sponsors, if the parent fail to submit the sponsor form and the requirements in time, Fr. Vince will automatically be the sponsor in the confirmation book.

**BAPTISMAL CLASS REQUIRED FOR PARENTS & SPONSORS**

Parents and sponsors are required to attend the baptismal preparation class prior to baptism. Whether the baptism will take place at Assumption Parish or elsewhere, parents and sponsors must complete the forms and provide the necessary certificate before attending the baptismal class. Canon law ONLY allows children 6 years old and below to be baptized as infants. Children who are 7 years old and above must go through the RCIA process first (Rites of Christian Initiation Adapted for Children, under our CCD program) before they can receive the 3 Sacraments of Initiation during the Easter Vigil.

Parents who are not married in Church must first schedule a meeting with Fr. Vince before they can attend the baptismal preparation class. The sponsors selected must be in good standing with the Church, if married, married in Church and if single, must not be cohabitating with a partner. The sponsor must be at least 16 years old and have received the three Sacraments of Initiation.



The next class will be on Monday, January 17, 2022 at 6PM in Truckee (Bilingual). Walk-ins are not allowed. Parents and sponsors must register first at the office in order to attend. Please call the office for the form and to sign-up (530) 587-3595. For the Baptismal Preparation Class, the Parish is asking a donation of \$20 per couple and \$ 20 for the pair sponsors. The suggested donation for baptism is \$50.
