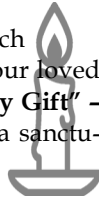

To avoid any confusion, only family members or the official caregiver of the sick person will be allowed to make arrangement concerning the sacrament. With regards to the distribution of communion to the homebound, the immediate family may also request the office for Fr. Vince to go to their house and give communion. Due to the coronavirus, the Eucharistic Ministers serving the homebound are still not allowed to do their ministry.

The FRSC, on the other hand, remains closed because majority of our volunteers are advanced in age and are vulnerable to the virus. We hope to resume our services when it is safe for our volunteers to do so.
