GIVE JOY TO A FAMILY IN NEED THIS CHRISTMAS

This year, our Concern for the Poor Ministry will once again sponsor 50 needy families in our Parish. Each family will be receiving a \$100.00 SAVE MART grocery gift card and each member of the family will get a gift worth between \$15.00 - \$20.00. To help prevent the spread of the coronavirus, this year, instead of asking our parishioners to purchase a gift for a member of a family, we are asking all our donors to get an envelope from the Giving Tree and donate between \$15.00 to \$20.00 and the Church will be the one purchasing the gifts. You may also donate whatever amount for the grocery gift card using the envelope on the table by the vestibule in Truckee.

OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE CELEBRATION DONATION ENVELOPE

The donation envelopes for the celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe is now available at the vestibule. Your donation will help cover the cost of the flowers and choir for the said celebration. Due to the limited seats allowed by the county during the service, only those who registered will be allowed inside the Church. To avoid an incident of overcrowding, the Church doors will be closed 15 minutes before the Mass.

RISK OF EXPOSURE TO COVID-19 & OTHER ILLNESSES

By choosing to attend Mass, you are voluntarily assuming all risks related to exposure to COVID-19 and other related illnesses.
