#### **JULY 28 – DEADLINE TO REGISTER FOR CCD & RCIA**

We are reminding all parents with children who are in the catechetical age for First Communion and Confirmation to register their child in the CCD program as soon as possible. After the July 28 deadline, we will no longer be accepting registration. The registration started in February.

#### **EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE PRIOR TO CONFESSION**

To have a good confession and to avail ourselves of the graces of the Sacrament of Penance, we are asking all our parishioners and guests to do an examination of conscience prior to confession. We have examination of conscience booklets available in English and Spanish to serve as a guide for a meaningful reception of the Sacrament of Penance.

#### **HOW WELL DO YOU KNOW THE TEACHINGS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH?**

Today, a great number of Catholics believe that the knowledge they acquired from the catechetical program they attended for their First Communion and Confirmation are enough, and that they do not need to learn more about the Catholic Faith. Sadly, their faith becomes stagnant and at times ill-informed because they do not bother to learn deeper about the teachings of Christ and the Church. We invite everyone to learn deeper about the Catholic faith by logging in to FORMED.ORG. This Catholic online resource is a paid program (available in English and Spanish), but Assumption Parish already paid for it so that parishioners and guests can access it for free. Simply visit FORMED.ORG, put the name of the parish, enter the zip code, provide your email, and you may now start browsing to learn more about the Catholic faith.

#### **ARE YOU IN AN IRREGULAR MARRIAGE SITUATION IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH?**

If you are in an irregular marriage situation such as cohabitating without Catholic marriage, civilly married and no Catholic wedding, or divorced and remarried civilly without annulment, we invite you to see canonical advice from Fr. Vince, a canon lawyer, who was a judge and Adjutant Judicial Vicar at the Marriage Tribunal in the Diocese of Sacramento, to determine what can be done to rectify your marriage situation. Catholics who are in an irregular marriage situation should refrain from receiving communion until their marriage case is resolved.

#### **INFANT BAPTISM**

Parents and sponsors are required to attend the baptismal preparation class prior to baptism. Whether the baptism will take place at Assumption Parish or elsewhere, parents and sponsors must complete the forms and provide the necessary certificate before attending the baptismal class. Canon law ONLY allows children 6 years old and below to be baptized as infants. Children who are 7 years old and above must go through the RCIA process first (Rites of Christian Initiation Adapted for Children, under our CCD program) before they can receive the 3 Sacraments of Initiation during the Easter Vigil.



Parents who are not married in Church must first schedule a meeting with Fr. Vince before they can attend the baptismal preparation class. The sponsors selected must be in good standing with the Church, if married, married in Church and if single, must not be cohabitating with a partner. The sponsor must be at least 16 years old and have received the three Sacraments of Initiation. Monthly Baptismal Preparation Class

**The next class will be on Monday, June 19, 2023 at 6PM in Truckee (Bilingual). Walk-ins are not allowed.** Parents and sponsors must register first at the office in order to attend. Please call the office for the form and to sign-up (530) 587-3595. For the Baptismal Preparation Class, the Parish is asking a donation of \$20 per couple and \$20 for the pair sponsors. The suggested donation for baptism is \$75.

#### **PROJECTED NET DEFICIT OF \$17,323.00 THIS FISCAL YEAR**

Due to the unbudgeted maintenance of roof repair and roof snow removal expenses this year, we are projecting a deficit of \$17,323.00 this year. Prior to the big winter storms we had, we were projecting a net surplus in our budget. However, the almost record-breaking amount of snow we've had this year caused some damage and issues to our church roof. We will try to submit an insurance claim and see if they can cover a portion of our repair expenses.

**CONCERN FOR THE POOR MINISTRY: FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE EVERY FIRST AND THIRD FRIDAY**

Our Concern for the Poor Ministry helps our less fortunate parishioners and our needy brothers and sisters within our community. Normally, the emergency financial assistance is available every first Friday and third of each month at the parish office in Truckee from 10:00am to 12:00noon. All the donations we receive for the Concern for the Poor Ministry are exclusively used to help the needy. Because of your gener- ous donation, the parish is able to fund the following:

**2023-2024 FISCAL YEAR – DIOCESAN BUDGET GUIDELINE/ ASSUMPTION**

As our parish begins our budget preparation for the 2023-2024 fiscal year, we are asked by the Diocesan Finance Office to put into consideration the following assumptions.

- Lay salaries adjustment guideline 4.5 % salary increase
- Priest salaries 4.5 % salary increase, plus years-of-service step in- crease
- Priest Pension Plan contribution rate – 2% increase
- Priest Health/Dental/Vision Premiums - \$1,150/month
- Property Insurance – 30% increase
- Liability Insurance 5.0% increase
- Auto Insurance 5.0% increase
- Workers Compensation Insurance Rate – 2.0% increase
- Unemployment Insurance Rate – 0.7% of gross payroll

The above assumptions will have a significant impact on our budget this coming fiscal year. With all these considered together with our normal operating expenses, we are roughly projecting a \$64,690.00 deficit for the 2023-2024 fiscal year.

**PROPOSED NEW PEWS FOR ASSUMPTION CHURCH**

The temporary movable chairs and kneelers inside the Assumption Church are about 12 years old and are starting to show its age, dirt, and stains. Our volunteer cleaners can only do as much vacuuming them. In addition, the individual kneelers, in order to clean the floor must be placed on top of each chair by our volunteers and then returned back after cleaning and polishing the floor. With the proposed new padded pews, the kneelers attached to each pew can easily be lifted up, so that our cleaners can easily access the floor for mopping and polishing. We need around 28 pews (16 feet long) and 2 pews (about 9 feet long). The estimated cost will be around \$50,000 or more. We are still looking around for vendors and donors to help cover the expense of the new pews. Please contact Fr. Vince at (530) 587-3595, if you would like to help regarding this project.

**PLANNING TO GET MARRIED?**

All couples who wanted to get married in the Church must comply with all marriage preparation requirements of the Diocese of Sacramento. There is a mandatory six (6) months marriage preparation period, but we highly recommend a one (1) year preparation period, especially for those who are residing from another Diocese. Please see the Diocesan guidelines on mar- riage preparation on the bulletin board of the Church. all documents must be completed and turned in a month before the wedding date.
