We are reminding all CCD students and parents that the Mass attendance count starts this weekend. Each CCD student and parents must sign the form at the vestibule. Please fill - in the correct information. Students who wish to attend Mass outside of our Parish must provide a bulletin from that church with the name of the student printed on the bulletin and with the signature of the priest or deacon. Please make sure you bring a pen when attendant Mass outside of the Parish so the priest can easily sign it. Each student is allowed only a certain number of absences from Mass during the school year (see parents' agreement form). The student will be removed from the program is he or she exceeded the allowed absences for Mass.

BAPTISMAL CLASS REQUIRED FOR PARENTS & SPONSORS

Parents and sponsors are required to attend the baptismal preparation class prior to baptism. Whether the baptism will take place at Assumption Parish or elsewhere, parents and sponsors must complete the forms and provide the necessary certificate before attending the baptismal class. Canon law ONLY allows children 6 years old and below to be baptized as infants. Children who are 7 years old and above must go through the RCIA process first (Rites of Christian Initiation Adapted for Children, under our CCD program) before they can receive the 3 Sacraments of Initiation during the Easter Vigil.

Parents who are not married in Church must first schedule a meeting with Fr. Vince before they can attend the baptismal preparation class. The sponsors selected must be in good standing with the Church, if married, married in Church and if single, must not be cohabitating with a partner. The sponsor must be at least 16 years old and have received the three Sacraments of Initiation.



The next class will be on **Monday, September 20, 2021 at 6PM in Truckee (Bilingual)**. Walk-ins are not allowed. Parents and sponsors must register first at the office in order to attend. Please call the office for the form and to sign-up (530) 587-3595. For the Baptismal Preparation Class, the Parish is asking a donation of \$20 per couple and \$ 20 for the pair sponsors. The suggested donation for baptism is \$50.
