SEPTEMBER 24 & 25 - CCD MASS ATTENDANCE WILL START

We would like to remind all our CCD parents and students that the Mass attendance count will start on the weekend of September 24 and 25. This year, the students will ONLY be allowed 8 absences for Mass. On the 9th absence, the child will automatically be removed from the catechism program. We will still allow certain number of Mass outside of the Parish, but the student must submit a bulletin from the Church where they attended Mass, signed by the priest of the Parish.

CONFESSION SCHEDULE

One of the precepts of the Church states that the faithful must go to confession at least one a year. In line with this, we would like to encourage all our parishioners and guests to avail of this sacrament whenever possible. We have regular confessions in Truckee from 3:30pm to 4:30pm every Saturday and in Kings Beach, 30 minutes before the Mass on Sunday. In order to make a good confession, please make sure that you have done an examination of conscience prior to going to confession. We have the Examination of Conscience booklet, in English and Spanish, available at the Church vestibule.

BE A CATECHIST

WHO CAN RECEIVE COMMUNION AND HOW?

All practicing Catholics (at least received first communion) and are in good standing with the Church, may receive communion the normal way with the corresponding response prior to receiving communion. Those who fail to respond will only be given a blessing. To our brothers and sisters who do not belong to the Catholic faith, or those Catholics who have been away from the Church or are non-practicing Catholics, are asked to refrain from receiving communion. They may fall in line with their arms crossed during communion and will be given a blessing. See the USCCB Guidelines regarding communion in front of your seat (the colored laminated paper).

Vince, at the office, concerning your marriage case. All Catholics are bound to follow the canonical requirements for marriage for their marriage to be considered valid in the Church. Catholics who got married outside of the Church without proper permission from the bishop, incur an invalid marriage and thus, must refrain from receiving the Eucharist.

CANONICAL REQUIERMENTS TO BE A GODPARENT

The law of the Church is very clear regarding those who are eligible to become sponsors for baptism and the other Sacraments in Church. Must be at least 16 years old, must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation. In addition, the individual must be married in the Catholic Church, if married. If single, must not be cohabitating with a partner like a couple.

NO MORE MARIACHIS FOR WEDDINGS, ANNIVERSARIES, FUNERALS & QUINCEANIERAS IN CHURCH

We would like to inform all our parishioners who are planning have a liturgical service in Church that we are no longer allowing any Mariachi group to sing inside the Church. If you wish to use their service, you may do so after the Mass during the reception but not in Church.

CONCERN FOR THE POOR MINISTRY: FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE EVERY FIRST FRIDAY

Our Concern for the Poor Ministry helps our less fortunate parishioners and our needy brothers and sisters within our community. Normally, the emergency financial assistance is available every first Friday of each month at the parish office in Truckee from 10:00am to 12:00noon. All the donations we receive for the Concern for the Poor Ministry are exclusively used to help the needy. Because of your generous donation, the parish is able to fund the following:

- *Emergency Warming Center in Truckee
- *Education Assistance

Note: The Parish is not providing gas vouchers nor hotel vouchers.

PARISH REQUIREMENTS FOR BAPTISM PARENTS & SPONSORS

Parents and sponsors are required to attend the baptismal preparation class prior to baptism. Whether the baptism will take place at Assumption Parish or elsewhere, parents and sponsors must complete the forms and provide the necessary certificate before attending the baptismal class. Canon law ONLY allows children 6 years old and below to be baptized as infants. Children who are 7 years old and above must go through the RCIA process first (Rites of Christian Initiation Adapted for Children, under our CCD program) before they can receive the 3 Sacraments of Initiation during the Easter Vigil.



Parents who are not married in Church must first schedule a meeting with Fr. Vince before they can attend the baptismal preparation class. The sponsors selected must be in good standing with the Church, if married, married in Church and if single, must not be cohabitating with a partner. The sponsor must be at least 16 years old and have received the three Sacraments of Initiation. Monthly Baptismal Preparation Class

The next class will be on Monday, October 17 2022 at 6PM in Truckee (Bilingual). Walk-ins are not allowed. Parents and sponsors must register first at the office in order to attend. Please call the office for the form and to sign-up (530) 587-3595. For the Baptismal Preparation Class, the Parish is asking a donation of \$20 per couple and \$ 20 for the pair sponsors. The suggested donation for baptism is \$75.
