RISK OF EXPOSURE TO COVID-19 & OTHER ILLNESSES

**CCD CLASSES FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021:
CLASS & MASS ATTENDANCE**

In light of the current pandemic, we have decided to do home schooling starting this fall until after the Christmas holidays. Class materials and homework will be provided to all students. Online lessons may also be required. Mass attendance will be done in the form of watching online streaming of Masses. The students will be required to fill in the form with their name, the Church and online information where the Mass took place, the date and time, and the student must note what the priest said during the homily. This will be submitted to the parish once a month and will be counted as Mass attendance. Those who will attend Mass in Truckee, will just have to sign-up in Church and no need to do the online requirement for Mass attendance.

**MASS ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021**

Temporarily, the CCD students are not obliged to attend Mass physically in Church. However, all our CCD students are required to watch the Sunday Mass on TV or online each weekend. To make sure the students watch the Mass each week, each student must complete a Mass attendance form and provide basic information about the TV or online Mass they watched. The family of the students who registered for Sunday Mass at Assumption Church, must make sure that the student sign-up the Mass attendance form at the Church vestibule. Students who attended Mass in person are not required to complete the online or TV Mass attendance form. Mass count will start on the weekend of October 10 and 11. We are hoping to resume the regular Mass attendance after the Christmas holidays. Please stay tuned for further notice.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR THE SICK

If you or your loved ones are advanced in age, in danger of death, or will be undergoing a major surgery, you may call the parish office to request for the sacrament of anointing of the sick. To avoid any confusion, only family members or the official care giver of the sick person will be allowed to make arrangement concerning the sacrament. With regards to the distribution of communion to the homebound, the immediate family may also request the office for Fr. Vince to go to their house and give communion. Due to the coronavirus, the Eucharistic Ministers serving the homebound are still not allowed to do their ministry.

WEAR MASK & OBSERVE SOCIAL DISTANCING AT DESIGNATED AREAS WITHIN THE CHURCH DURING MASS

All parishioners and guests are reminded to please wear mask at all times, and to please observe social distancing at designated areas within the Church during liturgical celebrations.

ATTENTION ALL CCD STUDENTS: MASS ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 2020-2021

The name of student and the Church or website used to watch the Mass must also be provided on the form. This will serve as the temporary Mass attendance for our students until further notice.
