REQUIREMENTS FOR BAPTISM IN CHURCH: PARENTS & SPONSORS

Here are the requirements for baptism: Parents and sponsors are required to attend the baptismal preparation class prior to baptism. The next class will be on Monday, November 18, 2024, at 6pm in Truckee (bilingual). Walk-ins are not allowed.

- The child must be under 7 years old, or the child will have to take the RCIC first.
- Parents who are not married in the Catholic Church must schedule a meeting with Fr. Vince prior to attending the baptismal preparation class.
- Sponsors must have received the three sacraments of initiation: Baptism,
 Eucharist & Confirmation, and at least 16 years old.
- Sponsors must be in good standing with the church: if married, married
 in Church, and if single, must not be cohabitating with a partner.
- Baptismal and Sponsor forms must be completed and submitted together
 with the birth certificate of the child, confirmation certificate(s) of the
 godparent(s), if married, a copy of the Church marriage certificate is
- Please call the office at (530) 587-3595, for the form and to sign-up for the monthly baptismal preparation class. For the class, the parish is asking for a donation of \$20 per couple and \$20 for the pair of sponsors.

CATECHISM REGISTRATION IS OPEN UNTIL THE END OF JULY 2025

All new and existing CCD students must register each year with our catechism program. The deadline to register is on or before July 31, 2025, Friday. No late registration will be accepted. It is a two-year program for First Communion and Confirmation. For First Communion, we accepted children ages 6 to 8. And for Confirmation, we accept children ages 11 to 14. If your child has a disability or with special needs, please make an appointment with Fr. Vince to assess if accommodation is possible. Without the prior appointment with Fr. Vince, we will not accept any accommodation request during the catechism program.
