The Solemnity of All Saints is not a Holy Day of Obligation in the United States this year because it falls on a Saturday. The obligation is suspended by the U.S. Conference of Bishops. While not obligatory, attending Mass to honor the Saints, when it is offered, is encouraged.

MANDATORY PRAYER TESTING IN JANUARY 2026

This is a friendly reminder for all 2nd Year CCD students to begin preparing for the mandatory Prayer Testing scheduled for January 2026. All students are required to memorize the basic prayers and key teachings of the Catholic Church required for the second-year curriculum. Please ensure your child is studying consistently between now and the testing date. Please note that accommodations for students with learning disabilities will only be provided to those whose parents submitted official proof of their child's disability during registration. No exceptions or late submissions will be accepted. Preparation is key! Please check your class materials for the required prayers and teachings.

Please be reminded that all Catholics are bound to follow the Catholic form of marriage to have a valid marriage in the Church. ONLY those marriages done in front of a properly delegated church minister (Catholic) and two witnesses are considered valid in the church (Catholic Form of Marriage). Catholics who got married not in accordance with the canonical form of marriage are considered to be in an irregular marriage situation, and as a result, must refrain from receiving Communion until their situation is rectified.

For Parents: If you are not married in the Church, please schedule an appointment with Father Vince before attending the class. For Sponsors: To be eligible, sponsors must meet canonical requirements: (1) If married, you must be married in the Catholic Church. Please bring a copy of your Church marriage certificate and a copy of your Confirmation certificate. (2) If single, you must not be cohabiting or living with a partner. Please bring a copy of your Confirmation certificate. We look forward to helping you prepare for this special sacrament!

DESTINATION WEDDINGS AT OUR CHURCHES

Looking for a beautiful location for your Catholic destination wedding? Our churches in Truckee and Kings Beach offer a sacred and memorable setting for your special day. For intimate weddings, consider the newly renovated Mission Church in Kings Beach. For larger ceremonies, our beautiful Assumption Church in Truckee is also available. Please note that couples from other parishes or dioceses must complete all marriage preparations in their local parish. To get married at Assumption Church, you must also comply with all marriage requirements of the Diocese of Sacramento. Due to diocesan protocols for destination weddings, we recommend at least one year of preparation. For registered parishioners, mandatory 6 month marriage preparation is required (but preferably 1 year as well). A deposit is required to reserve your date at Assumption Parish.
