CCD REGISTRATION: FEBRUARY 2 TO JULY 31

We are inviting parents with children of catechetical age to register early for the catechism program. It is a two-year program for First Communion and Confirmation, and every student must register/re-register each year. For First Holy Communion, we accept children 6-8 years old; and for Confirmation Class, we accept children 11-14 years old. Parents and students are required to follow the parish rules stated in the contract. Again, please be reminded that all students who are moving forward in their second year must register once again for the next school year. After July 31, no late registration will be accepted.

- **Sacraments of Initiation:** Must have received the three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Holy Communion, and Confirmation (please provide Confirmation Certificate and Church Marriage Certificate, for those who are married).

- **A Heart for Service:** A commitment to serve at your assigned Mass times and a reverence for the Liturgy.

How to apply: Training will be provided for all new volunteers! No prior experience is necessary - only a willing heart and a desire to serve your fellow parishioners. Please call the parish office at (530) 587-3595 and Fr. Vince will schedule the training with you.

- **Lectors:** Proclaim the Holy Scriptures during the Liturgy of the Word.
- **Eucharistic Ministers:** Assist in the distribution of Holy Communion during Mass or to the homebound.

AVAILABLE**

To ensure a meaningful experience, we ask that you please: (1) Pick up a Guide: Examination of Conscience booklets are available now in the church vestibule. (2) Reflect Early: Spend time with the booklet prior to the service to prayerfully review your life since your last confession. (3) Stay Focused: Feel free to bring the booklet into the confessional with you as a "checklist." This helps you stay focused on the specific sins you wish to confess and ensures you don't forget anything important in the moment.

ASH WEDNESDAY: FEBRUARY 18, 2026 (A DAY OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE)

Join us as we begin the holy season of Lent. Please note the following schedule for Masses and the distribution of ashes across our parish locations:

Mass & Distribution of Ashes

- 8:00 AM - Truckee (English)
- 6:00 PM - Truckee (Bilingual)

Distribution of Ashes Only

- 10:00 AM - 11:00 AM - Kings Beach
- 12:00 PM - 1:00 PM - Truckee

Note: Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting (one full meal and two smaller meals for those ages 18-59) and abstinence (refraining from meat for those ages 14 and older).

A FRIENDLY REMINDER ON RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION AT MASS

The Eucharist is a sign of unity and communion with the Catholic Church normally reserved for practicing Catholics and are in good standing with the Church. Thus, we remind our brothers and sisters who are attending Mass with us under the circumstances listed below to please refrain from receiving communion. We do invite you, however, to come forward for a blessing by simply crossing your arms in front of your chest:

● **Non-Catholic Guests:** We warmly invite you to consider joining the Catholic Church. Please contact the Parish Office or speak with a Priest for information on conversion.

● **Catholics Returning to Mass:** If you have been away from the Church, you can typically return to receiving Communion by first making a good Confession.

● **Irregular Marriage Situations:** If you are in a marriage situation that is not recognized by the Church (e.g., cohabiting, married outside the Catholic Church, or divorced and remarried without an annulment), please speak privately with a Priest to discuss how your situation may be rectified.

● **Not Yet Received First Communion:** If you (or your child) have not received First Communion, please sign up for the Catechism Program.

To help foster a prayerful environment for everyone in our parish, we kindly ask all parishioners and guests to observe a spirit of reverence and silence inside the main body of the church. The moments before and after Mass are a precious time for many to sit in quiet reflection, offer personal prayers, or prepare their hearts to receive the Eucharist. To honor this, please avoid gathering in groups or engaging in conversations within the pews, aisles or in front of the church doors. We do encourage you to catch up with friends and greet fellow parishioners in the vestibule or outside the church building. By keeping the interior of the church quiet, we create a space where everyone can encounter the Lord in peace. Thank you for your cooperation and for being considerate of those who wish to pray inside the church.

BAPTISM AND REQUIRED BAPTISMAL PREPARATION CLASS

Are you planning a baptism? Our Baptismal Preparation Class is required for all parents and sponsors. The class is held on the third Monday of every month at 6:00 PM in Truckee. For Parents: If you are not married in the Church, please schedule an appointment with Father Vince before attending the class. For Sponsors: To be eligible, sponsors must meet canonical requirements: (1) If married, you must be married in the Catholic Church. Please bring a copy of your Church marriage certificate and a copy of your Confirmation certificate. (2) If single, you must not be cohabiting or living with a partner. Please bring a copy of your Confirmation certificate. We look forward to helping you prepare for this special sacrament!

LOVE THY NEIGHBOR MINISTRY - ASSISTANCE WE PROVIDE

Our "Love Thy Neighbor Ministry" provides emergency financial help on the first and third Fridays of each month from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm at the Parish Office. Those seeking assistance must provide a valid ID to establish identity and residence in Truckee or Kings Beach.

Registered and active parishioners are given priority. Please be reminded that we do not provide gas cards, hotel vouchers, and money to cover rent or bills. The other services provided by this ministry are as follows: Christmas Giving Tree, Hygiene Pouch for the Homeless, Educational Assistance, Meals on Wheels, etc.

- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, socks, etc.)
- Monetary Donations
