Frequent confession is strongly encouraged as a source of spiritual renewal, healing, and growth.

To help you prepare, **free Examination of Conscience booklets are available in English and Spanish at the back of the church.** Please use one as a guide before going to confession.

If you are conscious of grave sin or are not in a state of grace, please receive the Sacrament of Confession before receiving Holy Communion. Receiving the Eucharist while unprepared is a serious matter. Our regular Confession schedule can be found in the bulletin.

1. **15 minutes Before Mass**, each family will line up with the **CCD student holding a flower** and the parents standing behind them.
2. Families will **walk down the aisle one at a time** toward the altar.
3. When the family reaches the altar, **the entire family will genuflect together.**
4. The CCD student will then **place the flower in the vase at the altar.**
5. The family will proceed to their seats and prepare for Mass.

This special procession is an opportunity for our families to **begin the new catechetical year by placing our children and their faith journey into the hands of the Lord.**
